Best category- price is still \$1 per ticket with the ability to deposit the ticket into a container for the desired item.

Better category - pricing will be \$1 for 2 tickets, drawn by color

Good category - pricing will be at \$1 for 3 tickets, drawn by color *

Make sure to purchase your tickets at the desired table to get the correct color ticket for that category. * Winning ticket numbers will be called and winners will go to the appropriate table to select the desired item. IE: The first- drawn ticket gets his/her choice on that table. Then the second drawn ticket gets their choice of what is remaining on that table and so on.

Ice Cream Sundae tickets are currently being pre-sold for the same amount (\$3) as previous years. They are available from any A&C member ahead of time. Or you can purchase them at the door if we still have Ice Cream left. Don't forget to BYOB (bring your own banana) to upgrade your sundae to a banana split.
